The Big Picture

Whether it is your first time joining in with our Yellow Yorkshire celebrations or if you have been with us right from the very start. The main question is, what is the reason behind all of our exciting events, baking bonanzas, quirky yellow t-shirts and all of our fundraising efforts?

Simply put... At the heart of everything we do is keeping our two helicopters flying across Yorkshire and ensuring our lifesaving team are available 365 days a year to deliver the highest standard of emergency care. Since our very first Yellow Yorkshire launch way back in 2014, thousands of pounds has been raised. Without the generosity of our loyal supporters, we could not continue to do the work we do. So, from everyone at Yorkshire Air Ambulance – **THANK YOU**.

Meet our patients ...

Read below to hear the incredible stories of four of our patients and how we helped to save their lives...



Fraser Bennett

Fraser Bennett, a machine worker from Bridlington, faced a life-altering workplace accident during routine maintenance on machinery. A powerful electric current shocked Fraser, causing immediate cardiac arrest.

Responding to a call from a local paramedic at the scene, who had already restarted Fraser's heart with a defibrillator, a YAA Doctor made the critical decision to induce a controlled medical coma through rapid sequence induction at the scene, which was crucial to Fraser's survival, given his high risk of death. Air-lifted to James Cook University Hospital, Fraser awoke from his coma three days later. After 18 months, he has made a remarkable recovery, gradually returning to work.

Martyn Piercy

After an accident at work left Martyn Piercy with life-changing spinal injuries, the YAA team were dispatched and after an assessment on-scene, Martyn was immediately flown to Leeds General Infirmary where he was rushed into emergency 9-hour surgery.

Sadly, Martyn's spinal injuries were too severe, leaving him paralysed from the waist down. However, after spending six months in a spinal rehabilitation unit, his positive 'can do' attitude ignited a determination to fight against his diagnosis and regain some movement in his legs, with a long-term aim to walk again.



Chantelle Hinton

Chantelle Hinton's life changed dramatically on a freezing New Year's Eve in Doncaster when a car accident left her trapped for over 40 minutes.

Yorkshire Air Ambulance's critical care team, alongside local paramedics, rescued her from a collision with a tree on a dimly lit rural road. Chantelle suffered a fractured skull, facial palsy, a broken jaw, multiple rib, shoulder, neck, and spinal fractures, and punctured lungs.

Transported to Sheffield Northern General Hospital, she endured a three-week stay. Chantelle has made a painful and slow recovery, however, continues to grapple with side effects, including severe fatigue and cognitive difficulties, attributed to her brain injuries.

Our Recycling Banks

One of the easiest ways to raise money for Yorkshire Air Ambulance is by recycling your unwanted clothing and shoes.

Each year, around 300,000 tonnes of clothing in the UK are sent to landfill sites. By recycling your unwanted clothing and shoes, you can help save the planet and help save lives, by raising vital funds for Yorkshire Air Ambulance.

Working with our recycling partners, Recycling Solutions, Yorkshire Air Ambulance receives an agreed percentage of the sale of recycled materials. It is as simple as that! Good quality items which can be reused are sold to second-hand clothing traders in the UK and worldwide.

About giftaid

As an independent registered Charity, the Yorkshire Air Ambulance is entitled to HMRC's Gift Aid scheme. It basically means that for every £1 donated, we can claim back a further 25p from the government. So a £1 donation would become £1.25, a £5 donation boosted to £6.25 and a £10 donation increased to £12.50 and so on. It's a great way to boost your donation at no extra cost*

Please note we can only claim Gift Aid on personal donations, and not business or corporate donations.

Please ask your donors to fill in the **Gift Aid Declaration on our website** to make their donation eligible for Gift Aid.
