What is a cookie? A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that YAA may put on your computer or mobile device when you access its website. These cookies allow you to be distinguished from other users of the website, helping to provide you with a good experience when you browse the website and also allowing YAA to improve its site. For example, they will tell the Charity whether you have visited the site before or whether you are a new visitor.
